Our Early Childhood teachers are trained in early childhood music and are graduates from college music degree programs. These programs foster creativity, social development, and an understanding of musical concepts. MANC's age-specific programs provide the opportunity for joyful interaction among parent, teacher, and child on the highest level. Classes are offered for children from birth through 8 years. They emphasize the development of vocal skills, fine and large motor coordination, focused listening, and instrument playing; all critical to the development of the whole child and laying the foundation for later formal music instruction. Through the use of high quality home materials, the programs also provide opportunities for families to continue the musical experience in the home.

- to help caregivers learn to play musically with their infant
 - to begin developing sensibility, aural perception, a musical sense, and a sense of beat
 - to stimulate singing and speech so that children learn how to sing at the same time they learn how to talk

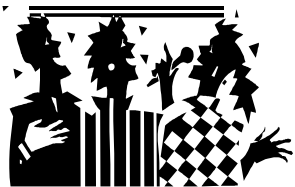
Blue Note Music Makers for Adults Happy Hour Chorus

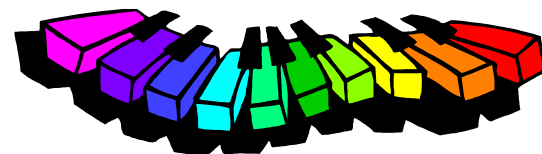


Blue Note Music Makers for Adults Recreational Keyboard
