**Junior High Camp:** This camp is geared toward the younger, developing trumpet students with at least one year playing experience. Time will be divided between learning about the trumpet and rehearsing trumpet ensemble music to be performed at the end of camp.

**High School Camp:** For students with at least three years playing experience, this camp will cover more advanced ensemble music to be performed at the end of camp. Topics covered will include the importance of a daily practice regime, college preparation, and fundamentals of the music business.

**Brass Ensemble:** This camp is open to students of all brass instruments who have at least three years of experience playing. Students will rehearse and perform in various musical styles, including Renaissance, Baroque, Classical, Jazz, and Commercial/Pop music.

Daily group instruction and ensembles will develop individual skills, and the camp will conclude with a performance for friends and family.

### Beginner Piano Camp

This camp is offered for beginning piano students in their first 1-3 years of study. Campers will learn about their instrument along with basic playing and performing techniques. Daily group instruction and ensembles will develop individual skills, and the camp will conclude with a performance for friends and family.

### Advanced Piano Camp

Aug. 9-13, Mon.-Fri., 9am-12noon

This camp is offered for piano students with at least 5 years of previous private lessons. Campers will learn advanced practicing, playing, and performing techniques along with music history, theory, and topics in music to be determined as appropriate to that particular group. Daily masterclasses and ensembles will develop individual skills, and the camp will conclude with a performance for friends and family.

\*\*No new materials are required for piano camps; however, students are expected to bring their own music (at least one performance-ready piece and other works-in-progress). Ensemble music will be provided.

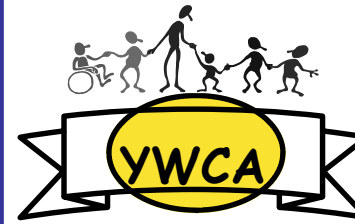
